


NOTICE OF MEETING

 - d. approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, including:
 - i. 8" Water Line & 10" Sanitary Sewer Line to serve the Village at Riverstone; and
 - ii. Avalon, Section 14.
 - e. deeds, easements, utility conveyances, and consents to encroachment; and
 - f. miscellaneous engineering items.

11. Stormwater Quality Management Plan, including:
 - a. public comments and training; and
 - b. amended and restated Rate Order.
12. Presentation regarding financial analysis services.
