


NOTICE OF MEETING

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 128 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, September 23, 2019, at 8:15 a.m.**, at **The Muller Law Group, PLLC, 202 Century Square Boulevard, Sugar Land, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

 - a. authorization for design of District facilities;
 - b. approval of plans and specifications and authorize for competitive bids or proposals;
 - c. approval of contracts, letter financing agreements, or cost sharing agreements;
 - d. approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, including
 - i. Avalon, Section 19; and
 - ii. 8" sanitary sewer extension to service Arista Riverstone Active Adult Community.
 - e. deeds, easements, utility conveyances, and consents to encroachment;
 - f. bond application no. 8;
 - g. report on generators for lift stations; and
 - h. miscellaneous engineering items.

11. Stormwater Quality Management Plan, including public comments and training.
